The Canadian Soaring Society is a soaring accomplishment program consisting of performance levels for flying radio controlled sailplanes.

The aims of the organization are:

- To bring together all R/C sailplane pilots, beginner or expert, in the pursuit of common goals and to enhance the sport of R/C Soaring at all levels.
- To help individual fliers become more accomplished sailplane pilots.
- To have more fun at the flying field by working to complete the tasks at each level.

Four levels of accomplishment have been established..Bronze, Silver, Gold and Diamond. Upon receipt of a completed membership application form and the \$5.00(Cdn.) membership fee, the Bronze level task sheet will be sent to the new member. As each level is achieved, the form for the next level will be mailed.

The initial (Bronze) level consists of relatively simple duration tasks and spot landings. Pins and decals are awarded at this and each succeeding level.

There is the initial membership fee and a fee of \$5.00(Cdn.) upon completion of each level. Fees cover postage, pin and decal purchase.

Membership in MAAC is mandatory for Canadian members, and for others, membership in their countries comparable governing body.
